- Monitor and maintain software including interpreting and recording data for 2 echometers.
- Collaborate with bat biologists.
- Monitoring the inhabitance of bat houses by regularly checking guano catchers.
- Update plant identification in existing Bat Friendly Gardens.
- Collect and organize photo data for various events, programs, and activities.

And the Education Program Co-ordinator will...

- Promote bat education at markets, Bat Counts, Bat Chats.
- Be responsible for bookings, crafts & communication.
- Be the main facilitator of Bat Chats & Trail Walks.
- Collaborate with bat biologists.
- Collaborate with Westbank First Nation to incorporate Sylix language, stories, and teaching into regular Bat Chat resources.
- Develop a Bat Buddy passport for enthusiasts to learn more about bats.
- Engage with Adopt-a-Bat members through email correspondence.
- Use social media to promote programs that support bat conservation education to people all over the world.

Both roles are full-time (30 hours per week) starting June 25 through August 26, 2023. The wage is \$18/hour. A valid Driver's License and reliable vehicle for regular transport of materials are preferred.
